Land update:

There has been a legal action filed by two members, Elijah Murphy and Lee Smith. This is the preliminary assessment of the attorney the insurance company has provided for the defense of the Club.

"Based on the foregoing, Plaintiffs brought a derivative action against the Saddle Club and Chuck Mahoney. The complaint includes two claims for relief: (1) demand for inspection of corporate records, and (2) waste of corporate assets. The Plaintiffs also seek a temporary restraining order and preliminary in junction pursuant to C.R.C.P. ss7-123-104 to enjoin (stop) the sale of real property owned by the Saddle Club."

The Board will keep the membership updated and share what it can at the May 19th General Membership meeting.




